



GIFT AID

If you are a taxpayer, the money that you give to the church can count for much more if you sign a Gift Aid Declaration form.

The signed form will mean that, for every £1 you give, we can reclaim 28p from the Inland Revenue.

If you choose to give regularly, perhaps weekly or monthly, we will let you have a supply of envelopes in which to make your gifts. Alternatively, you may prefer to set up a bankers order and we can arrange this too.

Notes

- You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the PCC reclaims on your donations in the tax year.
- You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the Treasurer or Gift Aid Secretary.
- If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration.
- If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
- If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please ask the Gift Aid Secretary or Treasurer, or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR65.
- Please notify the PCC if you change your name and/or address.
